



SANDHURST ROAD HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Proposed changes aim to:

- Improve the shopping parades making them more attractive
- Make it easier for people to cross the side roads especially those with mobility difficulties, using pushchairs and small children
- Slow traffic to make it safer for pedestrians especially at junctions
- Provide more places to park bikes
- Provide timed parking bays to support local business

Improvements

The changes listed below are planned subject to final inspections and checks by the Council. Improvements to shop forecourts between Lloyds Pharmacy and Sangley Kebab House will only go ahead with permission of owners of those buildings.

1. Footpath replaced between Shorndean Road and 27 Sandhurst Road
2. Footpath replaced between Sangley Kebab House and 20 Sandhurst Road
3. Shop forecourts replaced between Uptown and Street Flava to match paving
4. Shop forecourts replaced between Lloyds Pharmacy and Sangley Kebab House (requires permission)
5. Inset timed parking/loading bays outside: Sandhurst Supermarket, Hairtrix, Jubilee Cleaners to Leonards Electricals
6. Road resurfaced between Shorndean Road and Muirkirk Road
7. Road raised with speed ramps to height of pavement at Muirkirk, Shorndean, St Fillans, Inchmery and Muirkirk Roads junctions with Sandhurst/Sangley Road.
8. Narrowing of Inchmery, St Fillans and Muirkirk Roads to slow traffic
9. Guard railings at crossing outside co-op removed subject to assessment
10. Trees planted (Ginko bilboa Princeton Sentry or similar between Street Flava and Sangley Kebab where underground services permit.
11. Tree pit granite surround with britanny resin bound gravel
12. Cycle racks outside P&J News, Sandhurst Café, Launderette and David Atkin
13. Telephone box moved to Inchmery Road
